


Important Facts about Pakistan




Political and Administrative Structure

- Three Tiers of Government (Federal, Provincial and District)
- Four Provinces (Punjab, Sindh, Balochistan, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa,
- Provisional Status of Province for Gilgit Baltistan
- Karachi is the largest city followed by Lahore

Archaeological Treasures

- Mohenjo Daro and Harappa are the most significant archeological sites of Indus Valley Civilization (5000 years old)
- Taxila dates back to Gandhara period and an important center of Hindu and Buddhist religious traditions
- Mehar Garh and Kot Diji are even ancient than Indus Valley sites according to modern studies








Tourists Attractions






